We are back to online teaching and learning from Monday next January 11th.

Teachers from Monday will be connecting with students online following the students' normal school timetable. Student timetables can be accessed on EPortal.

Our school email systems – Office 365 will be used for all communication with students. The TEAMS Application within Office 365 will be used for online classes. Students will need access to a device to join online classes and access their email accounts.

Any device that can be connected to the internet can be used to connect to Office 365 email and TEAMS.

Students who have their own iPad should use that device. If students do not have an iPad then a laptop or computer can be used. A mobile phone can also be used. It will be important that students download the TEAMS App on whatever device they are using.

You can also use Xbox or PlayStation to access email and TEAMS – see steps below for each device.

- Type in <u>www.office.com</u> as you would to access Office 365
- Login and you can access Teams, Office 365, Outlook and OneDrive
