6<sup>th</sup> year: Leaving Certificate Applied Rm 227.

Students can access their timetables on the school website or on EPortal. In the case of 5<sup>th</sup> year students are not assigned to all classes yet so some blanks will appear on the timetable on EPortal. These will be sorted with students over the first few days.

We need full compliance from all students and parents in relation to the school uniform including the PE Uniform. If students have a genuine reason for not wearing their uniform they must have a note for their Year Head.
