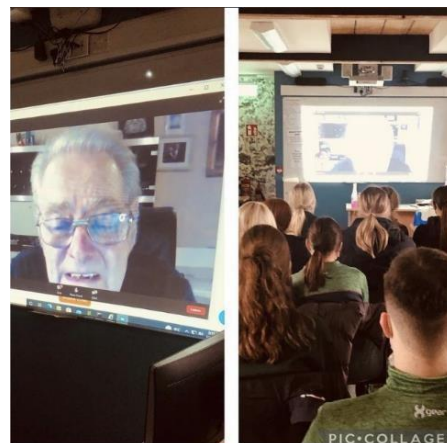


## Club na nÓg
