- D. Being a single parent family
- E. Other circumstances that would indicate a similar degree of financial hardship.

Applicants must fall into one of the above categories and must outline the type of hardship they are experiencing. Simply falling into one of the categories may not be sufficient to be eligible for the grant as there is a limited number of places available on the scheme and places will be assigned to the most needy students based on completed applications received by the **closing date August 12th 2022.**
