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- Introduced Ipads in Borrisokane Community College September 2013.
- iPads were optional – 70% – 80% of students used iPads.
- Last five years we made iPads compulsory for students in First year.



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Why promote Digital Learning



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- Use of internet for research.
- All students have school email accounts.
- Teachers Email notes to students.
- Students can email each other.
- Teachers can share resources on school online systems – Microsoft 365 – OneDrive, Teams, etc.
- Getting familiar with modern technology.
- Many apps can be used in class and for homework.

- Covers theft following a break in to premises or from boot of car.
- Any claims are subject to an excess of €75 which must be paid before the iPad is sent for repair.

Information regarding membership:

- Must live or work in common bond area (7 mile radius of BCC)
- Provide the following ID on account opening:
 - Photo ID e.g., licence or passport
 - Proof of address e.g. bank statement, electricity or broadband bill – dated within last 6 months
 - Proof of PPS number e.g. payslip, European health card,
- Once off account opening fee of €0.40 for adult accounts, once a year fee for Irish League of Credit Unions of approx. €2

Information regarding Education Loans

- No requirement to have account open for certain length of time prior to application
- Education loan rate 10%
- May be required to provide proof of purchase
- Typically lending under a 12-month period
- Repayment capacity important rather than savings history i.e. ensure member has ability to repay loan
- Need to provide documentation – payslips and recent bank statements

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Ipad Setup



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- iPad Supplier Wriggle:
 - Purchase on online Store
 - iPad supplied setup to your home.
 - School Books ordered through school and setup on iPad during first week in school
- All new iPads are setup on a Manged System
 - Controls the Setup of the iPad.
 - Only School requested Apps installed
 - Limit to Educational Use.
 - Support available to Parents from Wriggle
 - Training materials available online from Wriggle



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Preused Ipads.



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- Need to be relatively new for use of current apps and software.
- Storage needs to be considered.
 - New iPad minimum 64GB
 - Old iPads may be 16GB or 32GB
- iPad will be used for six years – need to consider.



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Payment Schedule



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- Purchase iPad from online store - €446.00
- Store opens 21st March and closes 7th June.

Payment to school of €350.00

- €200 by June 30th 2023. Can be paid in instalments on electronic payment system
- €100 by August 15th 2023. Can be paid in instalments on electronic payment system
- €50 in December 2023.
- Payments for Year 2 and Year 3 by end of June 2024 and 2025.
- Payment in Year 2 and 3 for iPad Insurance, Personal Accident Insurance, Journal: €50/yr.
