Number of pupils opting for a subject Class size

- Maximum 24, 30
- Minimum 10 approx.

2. Two required subjects on one line when making choices

# Constraints on achieving Options (contd) 

3. Availability of Teaching Staff
e.g. 32 students ask for subject $X$

- class size maximum 24
- no teacher available to form a second class

Result: Eight students will be placed in another class on that option line based on Preference 4 and 5
